Re Dubai Year 7 Football Tournament

Your son has been selected to play in a football tournament hosted by Dubai College. The exchange will take place from Friday 9 March to Saturday 10 March 2007.

We will be departing Doha Friday morning and arriving back in Doha on Saturday evening. Final times will be announced once available.

The cost of the trip is QR 1000 including taxes, insurance, a trip to 'Wild Wadi' water theme park and lunch. A copy of the insurance cover is available upon request. Please would you ensure the money is paid into the Finance Office before registration and the receipt collected at second break on or before Thursday 15 February 2007.

If you would like your child to go on this trip, they must have their own full and valid passport. Please could you check the passport and on the attached form write in the expiry dates of the passport and residence permit. Please return this form to the PE Office by Sunday 11 February and, if your child is a non-British/GCC passport holder, a photocopy of the relevant pages of their passport must be attached. If your child requires an exit permit then you will need to arrange this yourself.

As with previous trips, students will take part in sporting events during the day and spend the night with host families from Dubai College. This means that our staff will not be able to supervise your child all the time and so cannot be held liable for any injury, which may occur, either by accident or through negligence of your child or others not employed by Doha College. We will obviously give clear instructions on behaviour at all times.

To enable these exchanges to continue it is hoped that the families of the students going on this trip will be prepared to host a student during one of the sports weekends held here in Doha.

If you wish your child to go on this trip please send him in with the correct amount of money and the required passport details.
